Kit List

Clothes

Nightwear

Underwear/socks
(including plenty of spares, the socks will get wet)

Trousers & shorts
(such as tracksuits, jogging bottoms, no jeans please)

T-shirts/tops
(short & long sleeved- football tops are ideal as they dry out quickly)

Jumpers/sweatshirts/fleeces/hoodies
(warm and long sleeved)

Comfortable casual clothes for the evening

Coat/anorak

Light waterproof top, with waterproof trousers

Hat and gloves

Toiletries

Towels (2 minimum)

Shower wash/shampoo, hairbrush/comb

Roll-on deodorant
(if used, please do not bring aerosols)

Toothbrush/paste, sponge/flannel

Sun cream and hat (fingers crossed!)

Footwear

Trainers for dry activities

Trainers that can get wet/muddy

Indoor shoes/slippers

Wellies/walking boots (not necessary but maybe be useful)

Other

Sleeping bag and pillow

Clearly named screw topped plastic drinks container

Labelled strong plastic bags (bin liners) for wet, dirty and spare clothes

Up to £10 in a named envelope or plastic money bag

Medicines (if required and consent given)

Torch, disposable camera (optional)

Insect repellent (again no aerosols)

Book(s), cuddly toy, small quiet games e.g. cards

Packed lunch – all in disposable packaging please

Small rucksack/bag

It is much easier for us to reunite owners with lost items if **everything** is named!

A suitcase or small holdall is better than a rucksack for packing, and keeping tidy. Please remember that your child will have to carry or pull their case along on arrival and departure, so make sure it isn't too heavy

There's no need to splash out on new things – most items will come back dirty, muddy and smelly!

Please do not wear/take anything of sentimental value, i.e. jewellery.

We are very fortunate to have secured another booking at the excellent PGL Residential Centre in Caythorpe, Lincolnshire. **This has previously taken place in March but with the current financial climate we have managed to secure an October date with a considerable saving.**

Residential trips organised by the school are an optional, but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially, and the course we have chosen this year will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

The cost of the visit is £164.00 and includes coach travel and full board accommodation. Please note that bedding is not provided, therefore children will need a sleeping bag and pillow.
