The journey to school was full of adventure for our newest pupils starting their first week of school.


We were very proud of the way the children explored and shared all of the

Is a great opportunity for the children to enjoy a relaxed start to the day in a fun and safe environment.

The Breakfast Club opens at **7.15am** and finishes at **8.45am** at a cost of £4.50 per session. A healthy balanced breakfast will be served consisting of a range of cereals, toast with milk or fresh fruit juice to drink. We accommodate any special dietary needs.

After School Club

After school club starts at 3.15pm and finishes at 5.15pm. There are a range of activities available, which vary each day, including puzzles, construction, games, reading and active play. When the weather allows we use the school playground and field for outdoor sessions

Water Bottles

Children are encouraged to bring a labelled water bottle to school each day containing <u>water only</u>.



Absence from School

When your child is unwell, it can be hard deciding whether to keep them off school. A few simple guidelines can help.

Not every illness needs to keep your

child from school. If you keep your child away from school, be sure to <u>inform the office</u> on



the first day of their absence. Ask yourself the following questions.

1. Is your child well enough to do the activities of the school day? If not, keep your child at home.

2. Does your child have a condition that could be passed on to other children or school staff? If so, keep your child at home.

3. Would you take a day off work if you had this condition?

We do ask that if your child has sickness and diarrhoea, that they do not return to school until **48 hours after**

their symptoms disappear.



This is in line with NHS guidelines.
