<u>Clothes</u>

Nightwear

Underwear/socks (including plenty of spares, the socks will get wet)

Trousers & shorts (such as tracksuits, jogging bottoms, no jeans please)

T-shirts/tops (short &long sleeved- football tops are ideal as they dry out quickly)

Jumpers/sweatshirts/fleeces/hoodies (warm and long sleeved)
